Children will need to be barefoot to ensure they don't slip on the stage, therefore we can only accept footless tights/stockings. Please make sure these are all named.

One being that if younger siblings come to school in the morning, please clean up their mess as we are finding lots of books/games/pointing sticks around the place after the 8.55am bell. It is great that they are coming to school to drop off their siblings but we need to work together to make sure we are keeping room 5 tidy.
